




Full breakdown of attendance for each individual student

Average Progress 8 score and attendance





Attendance: Year 11 cohort in 2018 from Year 1 to Year 10




Attendance: Year 11 cohort in 2018 from Year 1 to Year 10




Similar attendance for boys and girls (boys slightly higher by KS4)

EAL pupils have lower attendance in earlier years but it improves and is higher than non-EAL pupils in secondary


KS2 prior attainment



Gap between high and low ability pupils gets bigger in KS4 (3% gap)




Attendance: Year 11 cohort in 2018 from Year 1 to Year 10



FSM6 pupils have lower attendance (2% gap in KS3 and 4% gap in KS4)



Analysing attendance for each cohort of pupils



Average for Year 11 cohort only is 95.4%

Average for all pupils in all years is 95.7%

FFT can analyse attendance for each cohort of pupils (e.g. Year 9 or Year 10) and compare the school's attendance to national attendance for every national curriculum year going back over time to year 1








Trend analysis: attendance % by gender


For each of your year groups, how does your school's attendance compare to national?

- **Attendance reports available now:**

- New special attendance report in FFT Aspire (attendance to summer 2018)
- Student Explorer: attendance data for individual students (attendance to summer 2018)
- The new attendance report and student explorer will be updated with attendance data for 2018/19 academic year (to summer 2019) in early 2020 (with autumn census data)

- **In 2020** FFT plans to launch a new monthly attendance report for schools which combines:

- Historical **termly attendance** data from DFE
- Latest **daily pupil attendance** from schools for last 12/18 months using data from your schools MIS and FFT Aspire Data Exchange
- Schools will need to ensure that **data exchange** is enabled and grant permission for FFT to use your attendance data in Aspire
