Then you can do some art with your pressed flower. Perhaps you will stick it on a card to give to a person you are fond of.



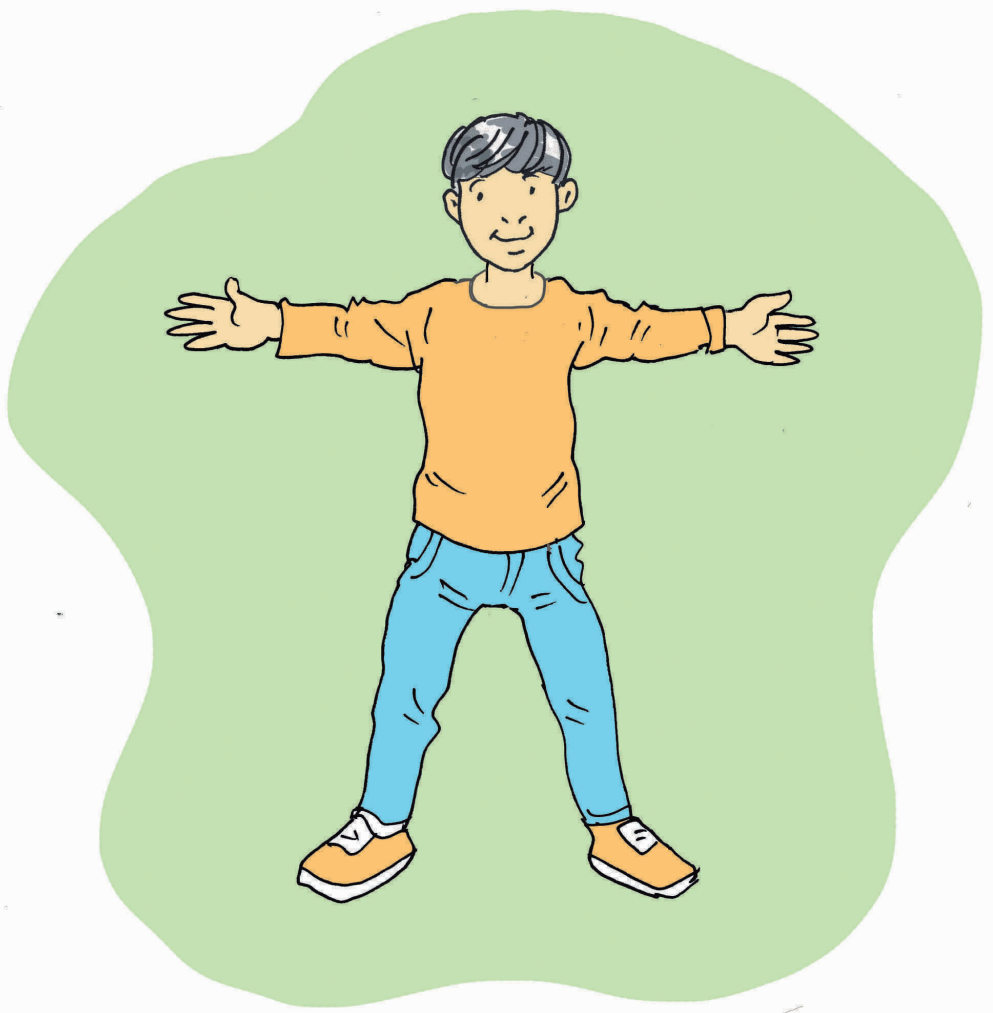
You can run!
